## Who?

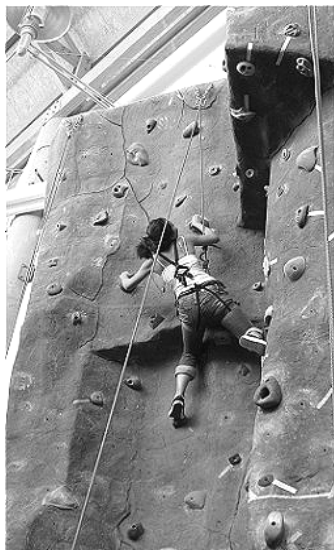
High school students from Idaho, Montana, Oregon, Washington and Alaska.

The Scripps Howard Multicultural Journalism Workshop is open to sophomores and juniors at high schools in Idaho, Montana, Oregon, Washington and Alaska. (Graduating seniors who plan to attend the UI fall 2009 are eligible to attend.) Students from diverse backgrounds are encouraged to apply.

Participants will spend the week working with professional journalists and UI journalism faculty and students. Participants will receive free room and board on the UI campus. A media-related field trip, a summer theatre play, a movie night and a barbecue are included in the week's activities. We also have an afternoon at UI's climbing wall and an evening at the swim center. Students must provide their own transportation to and from Moscow.
